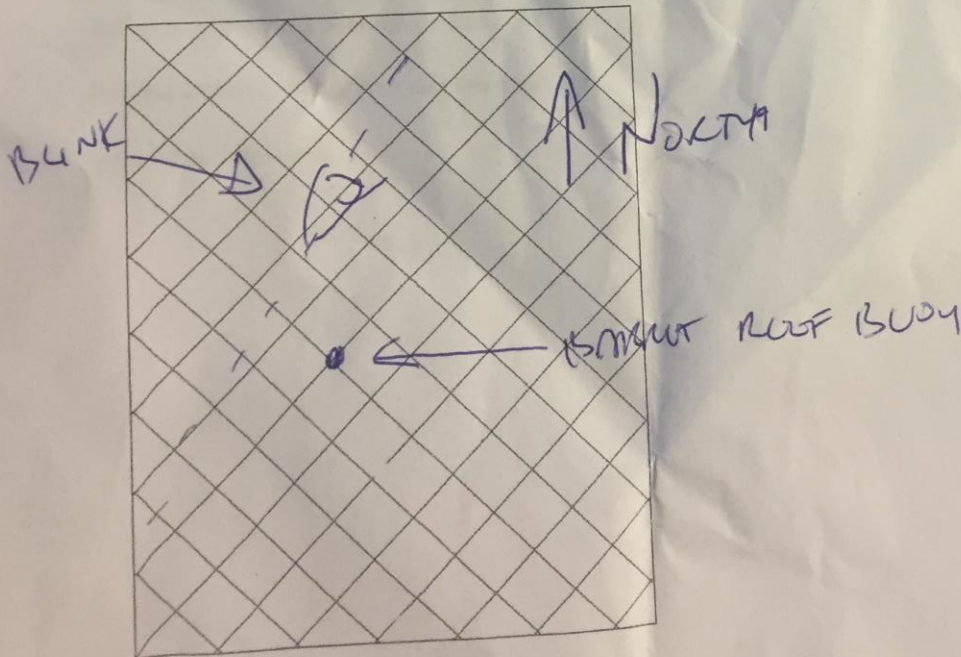

Validity: The Protest was valid and Proceeded.

Facts Found:

- 1. The Sailing Instructions state in SI 10.1 - Fairway Marks, that in Wellington Harbour, yachts shall pass east of Barrett Reef Buoy.**
- 2. On Leg 3 from Wellington to Napier, Blink sailed to the West of Barrett Reef Buoy.**

Conclusion and Rules that Apply:

1. Fact 2 above is based on the agreed testimony of both Parties.
2. As a designated Fairway Mark, Barrett Reef Buoy was an object the Sailing Instructions required a boat to leave on a specified - RRS Definition of Mark.
3. Blink failed to pass Barrett Reef Buoy on the specified side and broke SI 10.1(b)(1) and RRS 28.2
2. The Protest Committee has discretion to impose a penalty other than DSQ, as per SI 22.8 (b) and considers it appropriate to do so

Decision: Blink is penalised by adding 20 minutes to her elapsed time for leg 3.
